change. The Central Civic Center will continue to fulfill its role as a place for lifelong

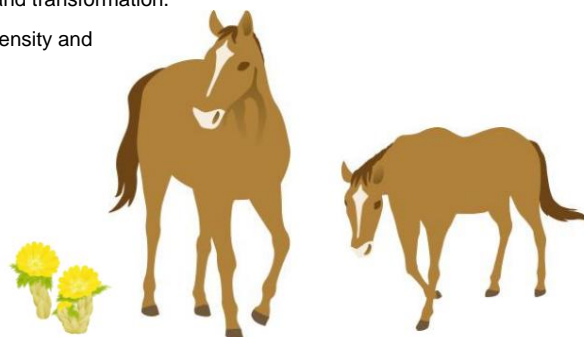
learning and a hub for community development. All staff will work together to make
