

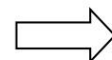

Capacity: Approximately 30 groups in total for Class A and Class B

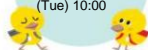

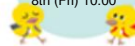

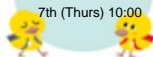

Neither the police nor the post office will ask for money over the phone.
