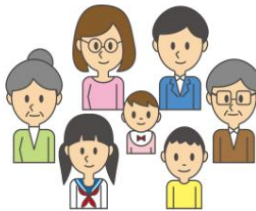
The community center is a place for local residents to interact, discuss, and engage in activities.

The Central Community Center is equipped with a lobby, study rooms, and a history corner, serving as a place for local residents to interact and relax. It is open for people to gather and talk, and can be used free of charge. In addition, the facility has soundproofing and multiple rooms.

In addition to a main hall and large, medium, and small training rooms, there are practical training rooms and a cooking room, which can be used by groups, organizations, and companies (limited to training sessions, etc.) for a fee. You can.

If you wish to use the facilities (fees apply), please apply at the Community Center counter (weekdays 9:00 AM to 5:00 PM).
