Natural disasters such as earthquakes, tsunamis, typhoons, and heavy rains have been occurring one after another throughout Japan.

It is occurring. Most recently, an earthquake occurred with its epicenter in the Kumamoto region of Kumamoto Prefecture.

An earthquake occurred, and a maximum seismic intensity of 7 was observed.

Column] ~ Let's prepare for earthquakes that could strike at any time.

Many injuries from earthquakes are caused by falling furniture or shattering glass. Please double-check that your furniture in bedrooms and living rooms is secured.

Also, in preparation for disruptions to logistics during disasters, have at least three days' worth, and preferably a week's worth, of beverages.

Stockpiling water and emergency food supplies at home is recommended. First and foremost, it's about "self-help" in your immediate surroundings.

On August 1st, we held a human rights lecture, inviting Mr. Hiroshi Hosokawa, the first member of the family inheritors program for atomic bomb survivors. —Participant Feedback (Summary)—

•I was able to learn about the feelings of the children who were lost in the war and the families who were left behind. Ms. Hosokawa's cheerfulness, singing, and friends were wonderful. The more diverse we and everyone else living today are, the sadder I felt about the loss of the lives of young people who could have lived the same lives. •The story was very specific, and the way she told it with such cheerfulness made me feel her feelings for her family even more, and made me feel the weight of having everyday life snatched away in an instant (I don't know how to express it). I was also deeply moved by the singing and piano. Words cannot express it.
